3. At the REQUEST A SOLARO ACCOUNT page, re-enter your library card barcode number

*\*Solaro will issue you a USERNAME and PASSWORD. Please note, you may update your password at any time but your USERNAME is set to ensure your online safety.*

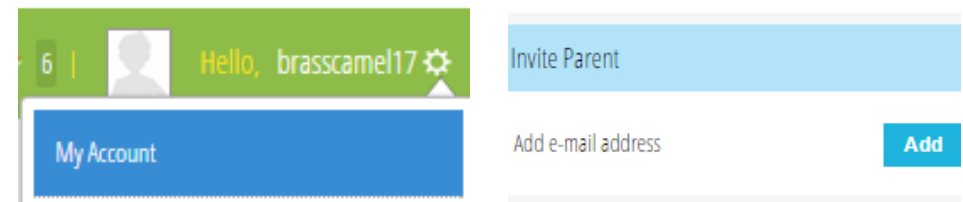
4. Accept the TERMS OF SERVICE
